Toronto Loader Training - Why You Should Complete A Loader Training Course - Anybody who wants to operate a forklift has to take a Loader Training program in order to become a certified forklift truck operator. There are a variety of ways to obtain forklift training. Programs are provided through workforce training agencies, company forklift certification programs, and approved on-line and video courses. The price can be minimal (or free of charge) when offered by occupational safety officers on job sites or through employment agencies.

In nearly all countries, forklift operators are required to be above the age of 18 years old. Local industry bodies together with local and federal authorities can approve the Loader Training programs. They require that operators acquire lift truck certification before operating a forklift machine. A certificate is valid for four years in nearly all areas. Businesses which hire workers to drive lift truck trucks can face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

Untrained forklift operators could result in serious injuries and property damage because of improper operation of the equipment. Training consists of the proper loading and driving methods. Workers must pass a written exam in order to be certified. A business will normally assign a supervisor to provide hands-on training to new staff. A certified supervisor should have extensive training in forklift safety and be certified as a trainer.
