Toronto Aerial Lift Training - An aerial work platform is a mechanized access platform. This particular machine provides access to otherwise inaccessible areas for equipment or people. Also referred to as an elevating work platform or aerial device, the device is often utilized to be able to access high areas. Construction and maintenance staff often must make use of aerial work platforms on the job. They are used by firefighters for emergency access.

The aerial work platform is designed to temporary application, providing access to high places. They are designed to be operated by one person, with the capability of lifting weights of not more than one ton. Several types have load limits that are higher. There are a variety of kinds of aerial work platforms; like for example, there is a "cherry picker" and a "scissor lift".

Some aerial work platforms are available outfitted with electrical outlets or compressed air connectors for power tools. For specialist tasks, like lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform may come along with special tools.

Those who want to operate an aerial lift machine need to go through training. Usually, the members of a Health & Safety Committee and their representatives are responsible for the inspection of each and every machine and work areas and are also needed to undergo training. Individuals training would become familiar with aerial lifting device operation. They would likewise know the regulations that apply to the safe use of these machines. Regulations vary in various provinces, and within federally regulated worksites.

Any worker who is required to work near or lifted by an aerial lifting machine should be told regarding possible dangers. In a general safety session, an Aerial Lift Training Video can be shown to be able to educate all of the staff who are lifted by them or work near them.

Aerial Lift Training Program comprises modules focused on the following: Hazard Identification; Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Platform Positioning & Park Positioning and Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices. The program is intended to train workers on the safe use of boom-supported, self-propelled elevated work platform and self-propelled, elevated work platform. A certificate would be given to workers who finish the program, signed by an individual qualified to verify successfully finishing a hands-on practical evaluation.
