It could be possible for delivery drivers to get work with simply a CDL, even though for some jobs, certain endorsements might be required. For example, delivering huge pieces of machines or parts which are very big for building projects would need the driver to finish further training to handle and haul huge loads. Usually, the drivers operate together with chaperone vehicles that are driven by trained drivers. These chaperone vehicles usually escort the delivery truck to its destination.
