Forklift Training Tips

It is essential that all workplaces using forklifts have the following checklist or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety regulations are being followed, each of these questions must be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural weakness which could cause damage to equipment, accident or injury.

- 1) Is the traffic of the pedestrians separate from the operating area of the forklift?
- 2) Is access to forklift areas by pedestrians restricted by a barrier?
- 3) The pedestrian walkways well-marked?
- 4) A sign is clearly visible stating a "lift truck in operation"?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Are changes to daily forklift schedules communicated to all affected staff?
- 7) Are lift truck tires suitable for utilization on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Forklift seatbelt is being used?
- 9) The forklift seat is in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Is an annual forklift certification and inspection carried out?
- 12) Is the kind of forklift right for the tasks?
- 13) Does forklift has a load chart that is readable?
- 14) Can the operators understand and read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for various attachments and uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work properly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured right?
- 18) The forklift overhead cage is fitted correctly?
- 19) Have all lift truck operators acquired certification?
- 20) Speed limits and warning signs are being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the lift trucks being used?
- 22) Forklift operators understand their responsibilities to report the damage to the machinery and other forklift incidences?
- 23) Prior to the machine being used, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed every day?
