Toronto Counterbalance Forklift Training - Counterbalance Forklift Training courses are always in high demand. The Counterbalance forklift is a forklift that is made together with a weight which counters the balance, equally distributing the weight of the load across the arms of the forklift. Counterbalance forklifts are made so the weight behind the center of gravity is counterbalanced by the weight on the lift. The load is projected out from the machine's front so it is visible to the driver of the forklift. This particular type of forklift truck should just be used on stable, level ground or on a prepared surface.

Forklift operators are needed to acquire training that will allow them to better understand the right or proper way across the arms of the forklift. The trainee would know to properly raise and lower the load vertically and how to tilt the mast of the lift truck, moving the mast between 5 and 15 degrees both backwards and forwards. Trainees would learn the RTITB standards needed for safely operating the forklift. Individuals training would also know the kinds of attachments for the arms of the forklift.

Kinds of Counterbalance Forklifts:

Walkie Pallet Trucks

The counterbalance forklift referred to as the Walkie Pallet Truck is best suited for getting into areas that are both cramped and small. This particular lift is really maneuverable and capable of accessing practically whatever tight spot.

Walkie Stackers

The Walkie Stacker is another forklift that differs somewhat from the Walkie Pallet truck when it comes to its lift height. This particular equipment is designed to access tighter areas and has extra lift capabilities for high stacking. None of the Walkie line of lifts could be ridden. The operator has to walk behind them.

Rider Pallet Trucks

Rider Pallet Trucks are designed to be ridden. These riding lifts are perfect for dock unloading and loading.

Wave Work Assist Vehicle

The Wave Work Assist Vehicle is a counterbalance forklift intended to reach great heights of up to 17 feet.

Sit Down Counter Balanced Trucks

The Sit-down Counterbalance Forklift is built in four-wheel and three-wheel forklift designs. These tough and durable trucks are made to be ridden.
